There are places for 24 teams at each regional event. Entries will be taken on a first in first served basis. In 2010 there are some new team criteria and categories for the regional events.

- To participate officially teams must be made up of 8 members, with no team member having represented the school in more than 2 sanctioned sports events per year. See the NZSSSC calendar of events for the list of "sanctioned" sports events.
- Teams must also be made up entirely of year 9 and 10 students. There is no minimum number of each.

Teams that do not meet these criteria may still enter, at the organisers discretion, but will be unofficial.

- A maximum of two schools may join together to form a team.
- Teams may enter into one of the following four categories: Mixed Premier, Mixed, Girls and Boys. The winners of each category will be awarded winners certificates.

Only teams entered in the Mixed Premier category will be eligible for a place in the Grand Final.

Please note that the completion of this form does not guarantee a place in the regional event. You will be notified by email to the address below if your entry has been accepted.

The entry fee for this year's event is \$150 per team, however there is a special early bird fee of \$120 for entries received before the cut off date indicated below. Extra teams, if allocated, will only pay the early bird fee.

Cut off date for the first 6 events is – 11 June 2010.

Cut off date for the last 6 events – 2 July 2010.

Important Details

All entries must be made through your school and the selection of students and teams is the schools responsibility. Teams that do not fit the event criteria may still enter (at the organisers' discretion) but will be considered unofficial. Acceptance of entries is the final decision of the organisers.

Regional Get2Go events will generally run between 8.30am and 3.00pm. Exact times will be sent out with final event information to the email address on this form.

Students need to wear clothing suitable for the activities they will be doing as well as bring a complete change of clothes. Teams will need to arrange their own transport to all of the challenges on the day. At least 1 teacher or adult will be required to manage the team. By taking part participants accept that school names and photos may be used for publicity purposes. The events are organised by experienced personnel in approved environments, however participation is at own risk.
